~ OUR COMMITMENT ~

- ~ I commit to promote the safety of children and embed child safety in everyday thinking and practice, and teach proactive behaviours in children.
- ~ I commit to support children and young people to understand their rights, contribute to child safety planning and raise concerns
- ~ I commit to establish an environment of trust and inclusion that enables children to ask questions and speak up if they are worried or feeling unsafe.
- ~ I commit to provide a high standard of child safety in my home and share this with all that enter.
- ~ Although all children are vulnerable, I understand some children face additional vulnerabilities, including the cultural safety of Aboriginal Children, the cultural safety of children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds and the safety of children with a disability.
- ~ I commit to listen to what I am being told by children - they may have a very different view to me or what I expect. I will acknowledge, value and take seriously the views put forward by children.
- ~ I commit to follow LMFDC code of conduct, that has clear expectations for appropriate behaviour with children
- ~ I understand the processes for responding to and reporting suspected child abuse
